stimulation induces thousands of Kegel-like contractions in 20-to-30-minute sessions, providing comprehensive strengthening of the pelvic floor muscles.

The PF TonerPro boosts cellular energy by penetrating cells, tissues, organs, and bones, improving their electrochemistry and membrane function, especially in



cells with low membrane charges. The device features four predefined programs for different incontinence types, along with options for customized treatment. Sessions offer adjustable intensity levels, easily controlled via a touchscreen interface and a control knob. The system can be used with the optional treatment chair, and/or a convenient optional cushion that can be used with most ordinary office chairs.

"Pelvic floor therapy is quite popular, and one significant advantage of the PF TonerPro is that it's non-invasive," stated Ms. Bengelsdorf. "Unlike some pelvic floor treatments, with the PF TonerPro, the patient simply sits on the chair, fully clothed, making it a very easy treatment. It doesn't hurt. It's suitable for individuals who are aging, have experienced pregnancy, or face other related issues. Many patients initially come in for incontinence and then discover additional treatment benefits for related issues, such as sexual dysfunction."

Ideal candidates for this treatment are men and women of all ages, including younger individuals experiencing dysfunction due to childbirth or pregnancy, she added. "The PF TonerPro treatment is safe and effective. It involves tailoring the treatment, clearly explaining the procedures, and setting appropriate expectations and timelines."

Patients report feeling better after treatment, though the number of sessions required varies. Some experience improvement after just two or three treatments, while others may need up to 10 or 12 sessions. "One of our patients noticed a significant improvement in her urge incontinence after just four treatments," noted Ms. Bengelsdorf. "To her pleasant surprise, she also experienced a substantial enhancement in her sexual health, which was an unexpected benefit. We hadn't promised this outcome, so her positive feedback was both spontaneous and welcome. Overall, the treatment shows significant progress for those with UI and other pelvic floor-related concerns. Many patients find that following treatment, they can jump and move freely with little to no issues, marking a substantial improvement in their condition."

After childbirth, the PF TonerPro can help restore pelvic floor muscle tone, addressing issues such as incontinence. It may also improve pelvic pain.

"One attractive feature of the PF TonerPro is that it requires no consumables," she expressed. "It's a simple, non-invasive treatment that's easy for providers to administer, and we are very happy with the results.
